Abstracts within 200-250 words should be submitted to ircontecs2022@biscast.edu.ph and must contain the following sections:

- 1. Title of the article
- 2. Name of the Authors (All Capital Letters for the name of the Presenter and Normal Case letters for the co-author).
- 3. Name of Paper presenter (1 only)
- 4. Affiliation
- 5. Email address
- 6. Track
- 7. Content must contain the following: novelty, objectives of the study, methodology, significant findings, and implication of the findings to onward Future-proofing of Society and preservation of Culture thru adaptive, agile, resilient Engineering and Technology.
- 8. Keywords (3 -7 alphabetically arranged)

This should be type single spaced, Time New Roman with a font size of 12.

Full Paper Submission

- 1. The final paper should follow the prescribed template of the journal with the following sections:
 - a. Title of the Paper,
 - b. Name of the Authors,
 - c. Affiliation,
 - d. email address,
 - e. Content includes: Keywords (at least 3), Introduction, Materials and Method, Results and Discussion, Conclusion and Recommendation, Acknowledgement (if any) and References. (Please find attached paper template).
- 2. Final Papers should be submitted electronically in MS Word following the Paper Template to the Committee via email ircontecs2022@biscast.edu.ph. Deadline for submission of full papers will be on July 1, 2022.
- 3. An acknowledgement email will be sent to the presenting author upon receipt of the final paper.
- 4. All submitted full papers will be evaluated for the selection of best conference papers based on the following criteria:








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Virtual Research Presentation Guidelines

- 1. Research papers for the parallel sessions will be of 10 minutes duration of recorded video and must be submitted to the committee through Google Drive on or before July 1, 2022.
- 2. The presentation must have a video dimension of 1280 x 720 (720p) using .mp4 format.
- 3. The research presenter must be present during the Academic Exchange after all videos had been presented.
- 4. This is the set of criteria for the Selection of Best Research Presenter.

Infographic Research Presentation

- 1. Infographic is another way of communicating information or research findings to different people through social media platforms like Facebook, Instagram or Twitter to reach wider audience.
- 2. Qualities of Effective infographics:
 - a. Takes no more than 30-40 seconds to read
 - b. Presents data accurately and ethically
 - c. Reference sources with citations
 - d. Respect for cultural diversity
 - e. The infographics must include the title of the research, name of authors, affiliation, Significant findings through visual and textual presentation and references (if any).
 - f. Size of the infographic must be in png format.
 - g. This is the set of criteria for the selection of Best Infographic Research Presentation.
