

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT:

This **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT** entered into by and between:

THE Eastern Visayas State University (EVSU), as SUC created pursuant to **R.A. No. 9311**, through its **COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES** spearheaded by the **NATURAL SCIENCES DEPARTMENT (NSD)** located at Quarry District, Tacloban City represented by its University President **DR. DENNIS C. DE PAZ**, herein referred as the **EVSU-NSD**.

And

The **BARANGAY 43-B** represented by its Barangay Chairman, **HON. TERESITA T. MALQUISTO** herein referred to as the **PARTNER BARANGAY**.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Eastern Visayas State University has an institutionalized Extension Service as a mandated Function, further emphasized under the Higher Education Act of 2012, to conduct Community Outreach and Community Development Program and Projects to deserving communities in the region;

WHEREAS, EVSU implements an Extension Services Program across colleges and campuses and in this particular, Science and Technology Environment for the People (STEP) Project.

POINTS OF AGREEMENT

ARTICLE I.

1. The parties approved the implementation of the Extension Services Program of the College of Arts and Sciences spearheaded by the **NATURAL SCIENCES DEPARTMENT** at Barangay 43-B Quarry District, Tacloban City
2. The parties shall consult each other and plan as regard to the total implementation of any fieldwork activities related to the extension project.
3. The parties shall help each other source out resources and/or materials for the Program and projects of the specified area coverage.

ARTICLE II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF EVSU-NSD

1. The EVSU-NSD shall inform its partner community of its intension to implement Extension Services Program in the Area and shall closely coordinate with the development of all arrangement to be made.
2. The EVSU-NSD shall provide the available skills and technical manpower resources that will be involve in its fieldwork
3. The EVSU-NSD shall help maintain implement the socio-economic development programs, especially on the ecological and environmental programs.
4. The EVSU-NSD shall further inform in writing the other party regarding the progress of the Program.

ARTICLE III. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BARANGAY 43 – B

1. The personnel of BARANGAY 43 – B shall inform its constituents of the presence and assistance of EVSU-NSD and shall inform their respective responsibilities in the development work.
2. The personnel of BARANGAY 43 – B shall ensure the safety of EVSU – NSD personnel in the locality.
3. The personnel of BARANGAY 43 – B shall facilitate the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the extension services provided by EVSU-NSD
4. The personnel of BARANGAY 43 – B shall provide coordination facility with other technical and fiscal support by allowing the use of necessary equipment available in its territorial jurisdiction in connection with the implementation of the agreed program.
5. The personnel of BARANGAY 43 – B shall issue certificate of appearance for on – site visit.

ARTICLE IV. EFFECTIVITY

1. The BARANGAY OFFICIALS OF BRGY. 43-B, Tacloban City shall inform its constituents of the presence and assistance of EVSU-NSD and shall inform their respective responsibilities in the development of the extension program and projects.
2. The BARANGAY OFFICIALS OF BRGY. 43-B, Tacloban City shall take charge in providing the needed venue and other needed equipment for fieldworks activities of EVSU-NSD.
3. The BARANGAY OFFICIALS OF BRGY. 43-B, Tacloban City shall ensure the safety of the EVSU - NSD personnel and students in the locality.
4. The BARANGAY OFFICIALS OF BRGY. 43-B, Tacloban City shall assist/facilitate in the implementation/monitoring of the Extension Services Program provided by the EVSU-NSD.
5. The BARANGAY OFFICIALS OF BRGY. 43-B, Tacloban City shall provide coordination facility with other technical and fiscal support and by allowing the use of necessary equipment available in its territorial jurisdiction in connection with the agreed program.

ARTICLE V. EFFECTIVITY

The agreement shall be effective, valid and binding for four (4) year from the date of signing by the contracting partners without prejudice to the revisions or modification of any or some of the provisions which may hereinafter be agreed upon the contracting parties that such revisions or modifications are consistent with the original intent and purpose of the agreement. Nothing may prevent any of the contracting parties from terminating this agreement for any unjustifiable reason upon fifteen (15) days' notice intent
