

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AS BASE HOSPITAL

KNOWN ALL BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT** is made and entered into by and between:

The **EASTERN VISAYAS MEDICAL CENTER (EVMC)** a Level 3 DOH retained teaching and training hospital with office address at Brgy. 93 Bagacay, Tacloban City represented by **SALVADOR B. EVARDONE, MD, MHA, MPH, CESE**, Medical Center Chief II referred to as the **FIRST PARTY**

-and-

The **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (EVSU)** with principal address at Brgy. 44 Salazar Street Quarry District, Tacloban City, represented by the College/University President **DENNIS C. DE PAZ, PhD**, referred to as the **SECOND PARTY**

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY has an authorized bed capacity of one thousand five hundred (1,500).

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY is an accredited institution of learning that offers college education and training programs, seek to provide its students with the necessary exposure and Related Learning Experiences (RLE) in actual worksites as part of the requirements for graduation and as preparation for employment.

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY has requested from the FIRST PARTY if it could accommodate the RLE requirements of its students in Bachelor of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics program at its facility.

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY agreed to the proposal of the SECOND PARTY.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises the parties execute this Memorandum of Agreement under the following terms and conditions:

SECTION I. OBLIGATIONS TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY BOTH PARTIES JOINTLY

1. Determine the number of students to be deployed at any given time to comply with standard ratios required by CHED.
2. Determine the area and timing of each activity that a student undertakes to maximize the learning experience.
3. Develop learning exposure and course design for students
4. Conduct orientation on hospital policies, which shall include but be not limited to infection control protocol, patient safety and data privacy, for the school personnel and student affiliates for the information, proper implementation, evaluation and improvement of programs prior to clinical rotation in the healthcare facility.

SECTION II. OBLIGATIONS OF THE EASTERN VISAYAS MEDICAL CENTER (FIRST PARTY)

1. To allow the student affiliates to use of its designated training and/or learning facilities for related learning experience.

2. To provide conference and/or training room for use of students during the didactic phase, workshop and related activities.
3. To provide a library equipped with books, journals and other learning materials to be used by students as references.
4. The student affiliates may be required to submit reports, case studies and other similar documents and perform activities that will contribute to the development of the student's knowledge, skills, and behavior required by the discipline and the healthcare facility.
5. The FIRST PARTY shall not entertain any complaints from parents or relatives concerning student's requirements, this shall be coursed through the SECOND PARTY.

SECTION III. COVENANT OF THE AFFILIATING SCHOOL (SECOND PARTY)

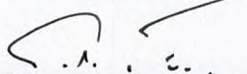
1. Pay corresponding and appropriate fees in behalf of the students prior to deployment.
2. Pay or replace with the same kind and brand any damaged and/ or lost item or equipment belonging to the FIRST PARTY which is due to the negligence of its students deployed at the premises of the latter within fifteen (15) days from notice.
3. To require students to wear proper uniform (where appropriate), sign attendance sheets, accomplish forms, submit reports, perform duties and responsibilities in accordance with the agreed upon training plan.
4. Ensure that the students observe and abide by the policies, rules, and regulations of the FIRST PARTY, and that professional discipline is maintained at all times.
5. Ensure that all data gathered from the hospital through interactions/ discussions held as a result of the affiliation shall be strictly made confidential and for academic purposes only.
6. To train its students on the nuances of the Data Privacy Act of 2012 prior to hospital deployment and be civilly responsible for violations thereof committed by its students while at the EVMC or as a result of his deployment thereat.
7. To be responsible for whatever injuries caused or occasioned thereto due to negligence of conduct of the school's students arising from or in connection with performance in their obligations under this contract.

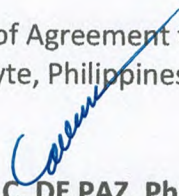
ALL PARTIES FURTHER AGREE THAT:

1. The contract shall not be amended or modified without the consent of the contracting parties.
2. The contract shall take effect immediately upon the signing hereof, and shall remain in force and in effect for twenty-four (24) months unless sooner modified or terminated upon the agreement of both parties.

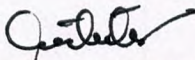
