MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement executed by and among the following institutions by virtue of the delegated powers to their representatives by their respective Board of Regents and/or existing laws of the Republic of the Philippines:

WITNESSETH: that,

WHEREAS, the Philippine Association of State Universities and Colleges Region 8 (PASUC 8), Regional Development Council 8 – Social Development Committee, and the Board of Regents of the Southern Leyte State University approved a research project entitled "Spatial characterization and Matching of SHS, HEIs, and Industry in Region VIII."

WHEREAS, the main objective of this project is to determine, develop, and implement innovative strategies and policies to strengthen the curricular programs of Senior High Schools in Region VIII.

WHEREAS, this project will conduct characterization, spatial analysis, and matching of Senior High Schools, Higher Education Institutions, and Industries in region VIII.

WHEREAS, the project has four component studies, namely:

- 1. Spatial Analysis of Senior High Schools (SHS) in Region VIII;
- 2. Spatial Analysis of Higher Education Institution (HEI) in Region VIII;
- 3. Spatial Analysis of the Industry needs in Region VIII; and
- 4. Matching of performance indicators of the SHS and the HEI graduates with the needed industry skill sets.

WHEREAS, Southern Leyte State University is assigned as the lead agency in the implementation of the project.

WHEREAS, the project implementation will be in Region VIII and the data gathering will be assigned to all collaborating SUCs based on the pre-identified areas of assignment.

WHEREAS, each collaborating SUC will gather secondary data and conduct online survey based on the objectives of all the component studies under this project.

Now, THEREFORE, and in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto have agreed as follows;

The Commission on Higher Education Regional Office 8 shall:

- Ensure the active participation of the identified collaborating SUCs in the region in the performance of their duties and responsibilities.
- b. Direct the private HEIs in the region to provide <u>data</u> and accommodate the focal persons and Research Assistants in the conduct of Key Informant Interview and/or Focused Group Discussion.

The <u>data</u> referred to include college admission and placement competencies in the different areas of specializations, including the profile of the HEIs in terms of Curricular offerings, Faculty Qualification, Equipment and Facilities, Teaching strategies employed, Time given per subject, Material resources, Physical Infrastructure, Budget allocation, student-faculty ratio, classroom size, and Academic Performance.

The Department of Education Regional Office 8 shall:

- a. Direct all divisions in the region to provide data of all the Senior High Schools including but not limited to address, tracks and strands offered, number of annual enrolment, and number of teachers and the educational qualifications.
- Direct all divisions in the region to accommodate focal persons from the collaborating SUCs in the conduct of Key Informant Interviews and/or Focused Group Discussions.

SLSU shall:

- Identify the areas of assignment of the involved SUCs and identify the specific Senior High Schools, HEIs, and Industry, where the involved SUCs will gather data;
- Conduct inception meeting where the project proposal and all the deliverables will be presented comprehensively;
- Monitor the conduct of data gathering of all the component studies of all the involved SUCs;
- d. Consolidate, analyze, and interpret data collected from all the component studies of all the involved SUCs;
- e. Prepare, present, and submit terminal report to PASUC 8, RDC, and the Board of Regents; and
- f. Accomplish other deliverables stated in the approved proposal.

The Collaborating SUCs shall:

- Assign focal person/s for each of the component studies with corresponding Workload Units based on their respective Workload Unit Guidelines with the following duties and responsibilities;
 - i. Conduct preliminary data analysis.
 - ii. Provide preliminary results analysis and interpretation
- Hire three (3) Research Assistants (RA) for six months with monthly salary of P19, 593.00 per RA who will;
 - Assist the study leaders/focal persons in implementation of the activities of the following studies:
 - Study 1. Spatial Analysis of Senior High Schools (SHS) in Region VIII Study 2. Spatial Analysis of Higher Education Institution (HEI) in Region VIII
 - Study 3. Spatial Analysis of the Industry needs in Region VIII
 - ii. Administer data collection in the area of assignment of the SUC.
 - iii. Maintain constant communication with the Study Leader and/or the Research Assistant of the lead agency

- iv. Consolidate the data gather and submit the same to the focal person and to the study leader of the lead agency.
- v. Perform other tasks as required and directed by the study leader/focal person.

The funds for the salary of the RAs shall be taken from the internal Research Fund of the SUC.

- Provide equivalent workload units to the study leader(s) in accordance with the SUC's policy;
- d. Establish partnership and collaboration with the Department of Education Senior High Schools, HEIs, and Industries in their respective areas of assignment;
- Conduct secondary data gathering, interviews, and online surveys within their areas of assignment in collaboration with the Senior High Schools, HEIs, and Industries; and
- f. Provide the SLSU regular updates of the data gathered;

Applicable Laws, Rules and Regulations

The laws, rules and regulations of the Republic of the Philippines, such as the Philippine Technology Transfer Act of 2009 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, the Intellectual Property Code of the Philippines, Data Privacy Act, Freedom of Information, and the Administrative Orders and Circulars of all parties involved, shall govern the interpretation of this Agreement. In the event of litigation, the venue shall be the proper court in the place where all the parties mutually agree.

Arbitration

The parties shall attempt amicably to resolve any and all controversies, disputes or claims arising out of or relating to this Agreement or a breach thereof. Any such controversies, disputes or claims, which have not been resolved within ninety (90) days after written notice from one party to the other party that such controversy, dispute or claim exists, shall be finally settled by arbitration in accordance with the Procedure of Arbitration of the Arbitration Law of the Philippines or Arbitration Law of the United Nations Commission on International Trade law (UNCITRAL) or the Rules of Conciliation and Arbitration of the International Chamber of Commerce. The venue of arbitration shall be the Philippines or any neutral country.

Effectivity or Term

This agreement shall take effect upon signing of all parties and shall be in full force and effect until the objectives are attained unless terminated anytime by mutual consent of all parties, provided that a written notice by any of the parties shall have been served to the other at least 15 days before the date of termination.

Termination or Cancellation

The termination or cancellation of this Agreement shall be agreed upon by all parties involved without the need of judicial action and without any penalty or sanction, at any time before its expiration. Moreover, all parties must be notified in writing at least thirty (30) calendar days in advance to that effect, which notice shall be final and binding on all the parties. Moreover, to protect the interest of the individual SUC should it later determine that it is no longer interested in being bound by the MOA; the SUC should have the option to unilaterally terminate the contract upon notice to the other parties.


