

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THIS PRESENTS

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is made and entered into by and among:

The **Department of the Interior and Local Government**, herein referred to as the "**DILG**," a government agency, created by virtue of Republic Act No. 6975 and operating under existing laws, with office address at **Kanhuraw Hill, Tacloban City** and represented herein by its City Director, **Atty. Darwin N. Bibar, CESO V**, hereinafter referred to as "**First Party**";

The **City Government of Tacloban**, herein referred to as "**LGU**", with office address at **Kanhuraw Hill, Tacloban City**, represented by its Local Chief Executive, **Hon. Cristina G. Romualdez**, hereinafter referred to as "**Second Party**";

The **Liga ng mga Barangay Tacloban Chapter**, herein referred to as "**Liga**", with office address at **City Hall Grounds, Kanhuraw Hill, Tacloban City**, represented by its President, **Hon. Eden Chua-Pineda**, hereinafter referred to as "**Third Party**";

and

The **Eastern Visayas State University Main Campus**, herein referred to as "**EVSU**", a State University, with office address at **Brgy. 43-B, Tacloban City**, represented by its University President, **Dominador O. Aguirre Jr., DM**, hereinafter referred to as "**Fourth Party**";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the approval of the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Reform Act of 2015 or RA 10742 on January 15, 2016 gave way to strengthen and empower the SK and transform it into a useful conduit for youth involvement in community development. Its passage reflects the vote of the Filipino youth's ability to lead and participate in the country's development.

WHEREAS, the Implementing Rules and Regulation, Rule V, Section 30 of the Act states that, "For the purpose of emphasizing the role of the youth in nation-building and molding them to become better citizens with the values of patriotism, nationalism and honor as a Filipino, any SK official, whether elected or appointed, or any member of the Local Youth Development Council (LYDC) must undergo the mandatory training program before she or he can assume office."

WHEREAS, the law mandated (Sec. 31 of RA 10742) the National Youth Commission and the DILG with the assistance of the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP), Local Government Academy (LGA), University of the Philippines - National College of Public Administration and Governance (UP-NCPAG) and in consultation with youth stakeholders jointly design and implement the mandatory and continuing training programs.

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WHEREAS, these Institutions conducted series of consultation meetings and orientation to the service providers to develop the program framework to include among others the overall goal of the program, target, strategy of implementation, accreditation system and monitoring and evaluation system.

WHEREAS, considering the magnitude of the task for the mandatory training, the DILG through the Local Government Academy spearheaded the development and conduct of Orientation and Workshop for Service Providers on the conduct of SK Mandatory Training.

WHEREAS, the said activity is a complementary track to reinforce the conduct of the SK Mandatory Training Program by the Local Governance Regional Resource Centers (LGRRCs). Local academic institutions as part of the Multi-Stakeholdership Advisory Council of the LGRRCs will be tapped to ensure a sustained effort in implementing the mandatory training. This intervention supports the NYC's strategy of providing the LYDOs trainings to lead and serve as training managers in their respective LGU.

WHEREAS, the LGU having the jurisdiction and is directly engaged with the SK through various mechanisms based on the provisions in the SK Reform Act.

WHEREAS, the LRI as training institution known for having expertise and is committed to providing high quality training and learning are believed to be capable in managing and facilitating the conduct of the SK Mandatory Training in their regions.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the above premises, the parties agree, through their authorized officials, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement under the following terms and conditions:

I. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

- a. Plan the implementation of the SK Mandatory Training;
 - b. Provide directions and guidance to the City Management Team for the effective implementation of the training;
 - c. Ensure that the training standards as defined by NYC, DILG and other partners are adhered to in the implementation of the said training;
 - d. Ensure the participation of service providers to include among others, local resource institutions, academic institutions and local government units in the delivery of the training;
 - e. Coordinate and discuss with the Local Government Unit the requirements of the SK Mandatory Training, including the role of the LRI as partner;
 - f. Facilitate the issuance of the certificate of completion to the participants who comply with the requirements of the training; and
 - g. Submit to the DILG, LGA and NYC a consolidation report of accomplishments on the conduct of the SK Mandatory Training.

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Local Government Unit

- a. Ensure attendance of the duly elected SK officials;
- b. Issue Certificate of Appearance; and
- c. Submit Observation Report with recommendations on how to further improve future trainings for the SK.

Liga ng mga Barangay

- a. Provide funding for the participation of the duly elected SK officials; and
- b. Ensure timely payment of registration/training fee to the Fourth Party.

- a. Manage and facilitate the conduct of the SK Mandatory Training;
 - b. Participate in the planning for the conduct of the SK Mandatory;
 - c. Provide venue for the conduct of the training;
 - d. Facilitate the purchase of the required logistics (meals, supplies and other incidental expenses in relation to the training) consistent with the activity design and where necessary, facilitate the posting of pertinent documents in the PhilGEPS website;
 - e. Facilitate the disbursement of the expenses incurred in the conduct of the training;
 - f. Submit to the DILG 08 Local Governance Regional Resource Center (LGRRC) the list of SK Elected officials who successfully completed the said training;
 - g. Submit the terminal report that includes activity highlights, outputs, registration and attendance forms, and evaluation results; and
 - h. Perform necessary undertaking, including regularly coordinating with the DILG Regional office, to ensure effective implementation of the activity.
