

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
KALAH-CIDSS NCDDP PILOT CDD THEMATIC IMPLEMENTATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement, hereinafter referred to as the MOA, is made and entered into this 6th day of June, 2018, by and between;

The Department of Social Welfare and Development, an Executive Department of the Republic of the Philippines, with the regional office address at Magsaysay Boulevard, Tacloban City, herein represented by **RESTITUTO B. MACUTO**, Regional Director, hereinafter referred to as DSWD;

The Municipality of Barugo, a Local Government Unit of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal address at the Municipal Hall, Barugo, Leyte, herein represented by **HON. MA. ROSARIO C. AVESTRUZ**, Municipal Mayor, hereinafter referred to as the Municipality.

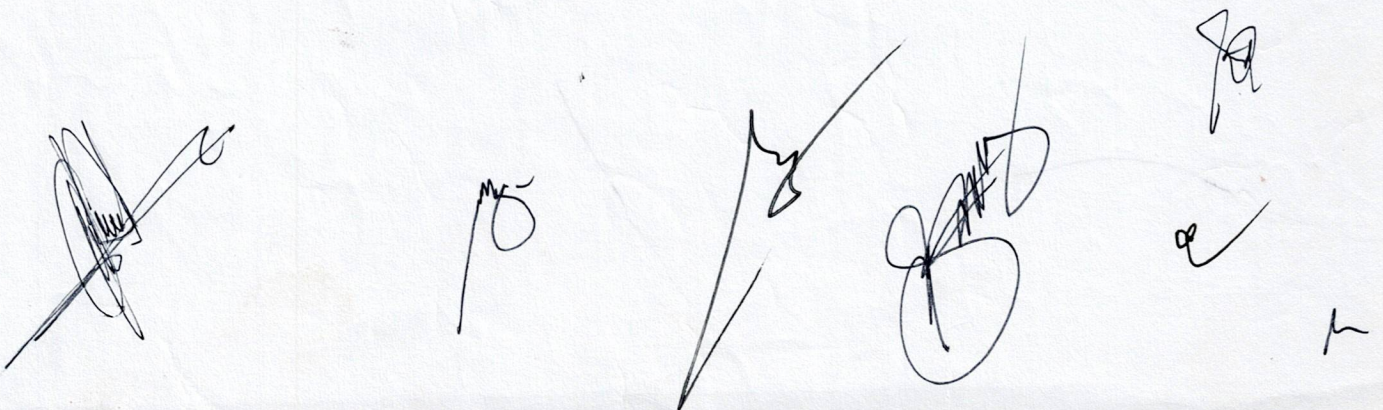

The Eastern Visayas State University (EVSU), an educational institution with principal address at Tacloban City hereinafter represented by **DOMINADOR O. AGUIRRE, JR. DM**, President, hereinafter referred to as EVSU.

WITNESSETH THAT

WHEREAS, under a Loan Agreement with the World Bank, a loan was extended to the Republic of the Philippines to finance the KALAH-CIDSS NCDDP Pilot CDD Thematic Implementation, hereinafter referred to as the "Project".

WHEREAS, the DSWD aims at empowering the poor, disadvantaged, and vulnerable groups for them to achieve a higher quality of life through implementation of this Project in order to realize this vision.



WHEREAS, the Project aims to empower local communities through improved participation in local governance and involvement in the preparation and implementation of the poverty reduction interventions on Solid Waste Management using the Community Driven Development (CDD) approach.

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code, local government units are mandated to address the needs of its constituencies, and empower the people through direct participation in the affairs of government, by allowing them the widest possible space to decide on, initiate, implement, and innovate on development activities that address their identified needs;

WHEREAS, the Municipality and its thirty-seven (37) barangays has been selected as one of the Project beneficiaries.

WHEREAS, the Eastern Visayas State University (EVSU) aims to develop extension programs and provide technical assistance to communities to protect the environment through sustainable Solid Waste Management activities in the Municipality.

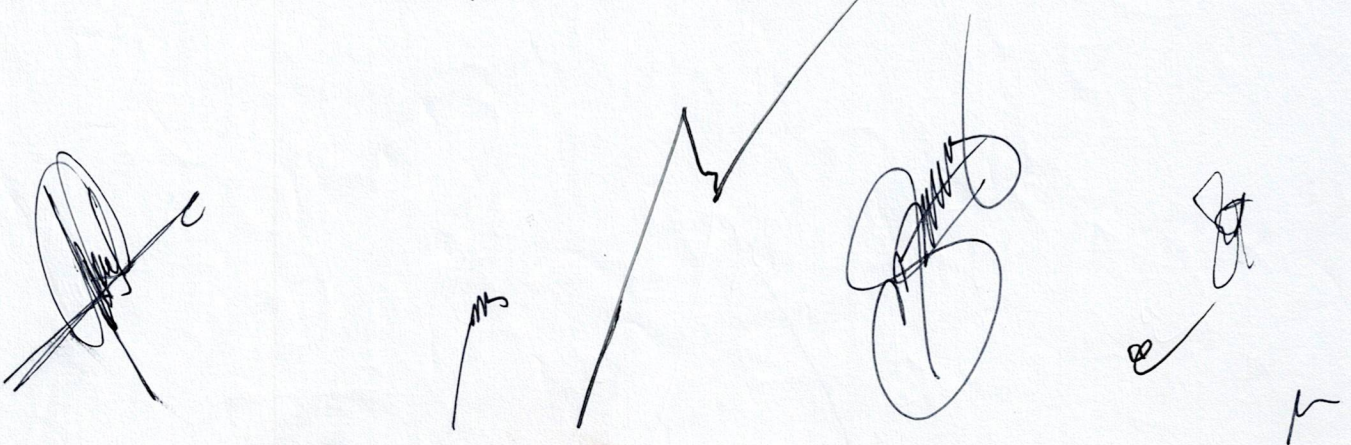
WHEREAS, the DSWD, the Municipality and EVSU are willing and able to partner with each other to deliver a package of services to address poverty, empower citizens, and promote inclusive growth and agree to commit each other to such partnership through this MOA.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, all parties mutually agree as follows:

I. AGREEMENTS

A. The Department of Social Welfare and Development, (DSWD)

1. Coordinate with the Municipality and EVSU on the introduction, development, implementation, monitoring, and assessment and evaluation of the thematic interventions to be implemented.
2. Provide the community with grant funds for small community sub-projects through a participatory, criteria-based prioritization process, outlined in the Municipal Program Implementation Plan (MPIP).
3. Monitor community-managed implementation and fund utilization in accordance with KALAHI CIDSS procurement and financial management system.

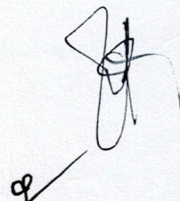
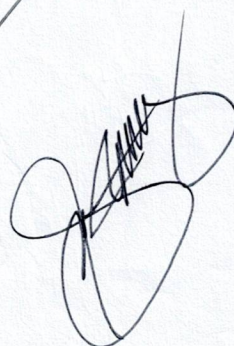
4. Provide technical assistance to the Municipality and communities to enhance their capacity for effective program implementation of Solid Waste Management activities as the Pilot CDD thematic intervention in the Municipality.
5. Work with the Municipality and EVSU in ensuring all Community Driven Development (CDD) activities are implemented in a participatory and transparent manner, in ways that build greater social accountability of government to citizens, while ensuring efficient and effective delivery of the results.

B. The Municipality of Barugo, Leyte

1. Crafting of a Municipal Program Implementation Plan (MPIP) along planning and investment programming, and facilitation and management of people's participation and other CDD processes relative to Solid Waste Management.
2. Provide local counterpart contribution in support to project operations which maybe in the form of cash or in-kind.
3. Provide technical assistance to the barangays in the implementation of Solid Waste Management activities as the Pilot CDD Thematic Intervention in the municipality.
4. Monitor and evaluate overall implementation of the project and recommend strategies for further improvement of the Project implementation.
5. Through the Municipal Coordinating Team (MCT) as the lead facilitator in the barangays, provide assistance and facilitation in all Community Driven Development (CDD) activities.

C. The Eastern Visayas State University, (EVSU)

1. Provide technical assistance on the introduction, development, implementation, monitoring, assessment and evaluation of the thematic interventions to be implemented.
2. Provide assistance in the environmental scanning and pre-engineering works such as survey, data gathering, research and database information system design for SWM.
3. Provide capability building activities for the Barangay through formal trainings or coaching.
4. Provide assistance in preparation of IEC materials and other Solid Waste Management advocacy activities.
5. Provide technical supervision and administration in the implementation of Solid Waste Management interventions as Pilot CDD Thematic Area to be implemented in the Municipality.



6. Conduct monitoring and assessment on the progress of the project and recommend strategies for further improvement of project implementation.

II. AMENDMENTS

This Memorandum of Agreement maybe amended in part or in full through a written proposal by either party, subject to negotiations and mutual agreement by the parties. This agreement may be rescinded or terminated upon written notice by any party.

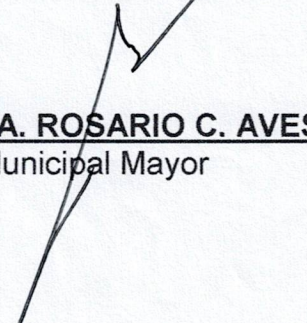
This agreement shall take effect upon signing by all parties concerned.
