MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **Memorandum of Agreement** is made and entered into at the EVSU Main Campus, Tacloban City, Leyte, Philippines on _____, by and between;

The **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY**, a state university created by Republic Act No. 9311, with office address at Quarry District, Tacloban City, Leyte, Philippines, represented herein by its President, **DR. DOMINADOR O. AGUIRRE, JR.**, and hereinafter referred to as "**EVSU**",

- and -

The **MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF DULAG, LEYTE**, a local government entity in the Province of Leyte, whose thrust is to deliver governmental and proprietary functions to its local constituents with present address at Brgy. Buntay, Dulag, Leyte, as represented in this Act by its Municipal Mayor, **ATTY. MILDRED JOY QUE**, hereinafter referred to as "**LGU-DULAG**";

(Hereinafter, EVSU and LGU-Dulag shall be individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties")

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Sec. 2 of RA 9311 states that EVSU shall primarily provided advanced education, higher technological, professional instruction and training in trade, fishery, agriculture, forestry, science, education, commerce, architecture, engineering and related courses. It shall also **undertake research and extension services** and provide progressive leadership in its areas of specialization;

WHEREAS, EVSU is mandated to perform four major functions: Instruction, Research, Production, and Extension Services;

WHEREAS, EVSU implements extension service programs among its immediate communities;

WHEREAS, EVSU (formerly LIT), LGU-Dulag, 2nd Congressional District of Leyte and Department of Education has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement last 5 June 2000 establishing an LIT campus in the municipality of Dulag, Leyte;

WHEREAS, LGU-Dulag recognizes and responds to the needs of its constituents through the provision of relevant educational programs to uplift their social well-being and quality of life;

WHEREAS, LGU-Dulag, in its desire to address the educational needs of its constituents, aims to complement its meaningful partnership with EVSU for technical skills assistance and consultancy specifically on field of information technology pursuant to the 5 June 2000 MOA which requires LIT (now EVSU) to assume responsibility in the preparation of the academic programs for every school year and to extend the necessary expertise needed by the extension campus;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree on the following:

ARTICLE I


RESPONSIBILITIES OF LGU-DULAG

1. Inform and coordinate with EVSU the conduct of the operation, improvement for good governance, and projects that will require necessary technical assistance from EVSU regarding the implementation of the BSIT Program in the EVSU Dulag Extension Campus.
2. LGU-Dulag shall ensure the availability of supplies, equipment and/or materials to be used by the EVSU personnel when extending skills and technical assistance to IT and other corollary activities;
3. LGU-Dulag shall ensure the safety and security of the skills and technical manpower resources sent by EVSU to any of the program and projects implemented by the IT Department;
4. Provide assistance to EVSU Personnel/Faculty in the form of but not limited to honorarium and traveling expenses for the services of personnel from EVSU, et.al, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
5. Submit periodic reports as may be needed by the concerned contracting parties.

ARTICLE II

RESPONSIBILITIES OF EVSU

1. EVSU shall inform LGU-Dulag of its intention to implement Extension Service Program in the identified area and shall closely coordinate with LGU-Dulag on all arrangements to be made.
2. EVSU shall provide the available skills and technical manpower resources that will be involved in its field work activities based on the needs of LGU-Dulag and its immediate community.
3. EVSU will inform LGU-Dulag in writing regarding the progress of the program and will spearhead the conduct of appropriate monitoring and evaluation schemes at various points for the duration of the agreement.
4. Provide assistance in the preparation of its BSIT academic program for the EVSU Dulag Extension Campus, to wit:
 - a. Assist in the selection, hiring, and programming of faculty members;
 - b. Assist in the general supervision of the BSIT Program;
 - c. Provide related expertise needed by the BSIT Program;
 - d. Extend invitations on trainings and other academic and professional continuing education for its professors.

ARTICLE III
EFFECTIVITY

The agreement shall be effective, valid and binding for **three (3) years** from the date of signing by the contracting parties without prejudice to the revision or modification of any or some of the provisions which may hereinafter be agreed upon by the contracting parties that such provision or modification is consistent with the original intent and purpose of the agreement. Nothing may prevent any of the contracting parties from terminating this agreement for any justifiable reason upon fifteen (15) days written notice of its intent.
