MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT:

This **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT** made and entered into at Burauen, Leyte, Philippines on February 4, 2022 by and between

The **BUSINESS, ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT (BEMD) OF EASTERN VISSAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY – BURAUEN CAMPUS** of Burauen, Leyte represented by its Campus Director, **EDUARDO A. BAGAS, Ed.D.**,

And

The **BARANGAY SAN DIEGO, DISTRICT IX**, represented by its Barangay Chairperson, **HON. ISIDORO J. CINCO, JR.**,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, BEMD of EVSU – Burauen Campus is a higher learning institution mandated to develop potentialities the locality of Burauen, Leyte and in Region VIII;

WHEREAS, BEMD of EVSU – Burauen Campus is mandated with four (4) major functions, the instruction, research, production and extension services;

WHEREAS, BEMD of EVSU – Burauen Campus is mandated to implement extension services through its “Developing Advantage through Sustainable and Inclusive Growth Initiatives (DASIGI) Program to its immediate adopted communities, development partners and identified clients;

WHEREAS, BARANGAY SAN DIEGO, DISTRICT IX is enjoined to develop linkage and networking with academic and other institutions to meet its goal of income generation for its constituents;

WHEREAS, BARANGAY SAN DIEGO, DISTRICT IX in its intention of providing livelihood and job opportunities to various sectors of the region engage in meaningful partnership with **BEMD** for livelihood, office management and other relevant technical skills assistance and consultancy beneficial to the barangay;

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NOW, THEREFORE or and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree and stipulate:

A. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BEMD-EVSU BURAUEN CAMPUS

1. The BEMD faculty, staff and students shall provide available entrepreneurial skills, office management skills and other relevant technical manpower resources to the Barangay San Diego, District IX whenever required by the latter's various livelihood and other socio-development programs;
2. Share in the counterpart of any supplies or materials required by its personnel in the conduct of skills and technical assistance to Barangay San Diego, District IX; and
3. The BEMD shall inform the Barangay San Diego, District IX, of the possible and potential program of the University related to office management, livelihood and other developmental projects responsive to the needs of the barangay community stakeholders.

B. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BARANGAY SAN DIEGO, DISTRICT IX

1. Inform and coordinate with BEMD the conduct of various programs and projects that will require necessary technical assistance from the said department,
2. They shall ensure the availability of supplies and/or materials to be used by the BEMD personnel when extending skills and technical assistance for their various extension activities;
3. The partnered barangay shall ensure the security of the skills and technical manpower resources sent by the BEMD to any of the program and projects implemented by them,
4. They shall ensure the availability of the participants and the proper venue and technical equipment needed for the implementation of the various technical skills delivered by BEMD, and
5. The Barangay San Diego, District IX and BEMD shall apportion financial resources allocation from their respective funds in order to defray the necessary expenses for the training. This will be subject to the availability of funds from both engaging party.

C. UNDER THIS AGREEMENT, THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS ARE LIKEWISE INCLUDED:


1. It is expressly understood that there will be no employer-employee relationship between the Barangay San Diego, District IX and BEMD EVSU - Bureau personnel extending assistance, and

2. BEMD EVSU – Bureau shall defend, indemnify and hold Barangay San Diego, District IX its, officers, officials, employees and volunteers harmless from any and all claims, injuries, damages, loss or suits including attorney fees, arising out of or resulting from the acts, errors or omissions of BEMD personnel in the performance of this Agreement, except for injuries and damages caused by the sole negligence of Barangay San Diego, District IX.


D. EFFECTIVITY

The Agreement shall be effective, valid and binding for **FIVE (5) YEARS** from the date of signing by the contracting parties without prejudice to the revision or modification of any or some of the provisions which may hereinafter be agreed upon the contracting parties that such provision or modification are consistent with the original intent and purpose of the Agreement. Nothing may prevent any of the contracting parties from terminating this Agreement for any justifiable reason upon fifteen (15) days of notice
