The **Alternative Learning System (ALS) BARUGO II DISTRICT** of Barugo, Leyte, represented by its PSD/ALS Manager, **AMBROSIO A. COQUIA, JR.**, Herein after referred to as **ALS BARUGO II**.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, **EVSU** is a higher learning institution mandated to develop potentialities of Metro Carigara;

WHEREAS, **EVSU** is mandated with four major functions, the instruction research, production and extension services;

WHEREAS, **EVSU** is mandated to implement extension services program to its immediate communities and to its development partners and identified client;

WHEREAS, **the EVSU** is mandated to implement a research -based extension services program of the Education Department, Fisheries Department, Entrepreneurship Department, and Information Department and in this particular the programs of:

Education: Bachelor of Secondary Education Major in Science (BSED Science)

Bachelor of Secondary Education Major in mathematics (BSED- mathematics)



Bachelor of Technical-Vocational Teacher Education

WHEREAS, the **ALS BARUGO II** are enjoined to develop linkage and networking with academic and other institutions to meet its goal of improving its operation for better services to its constitutions;

WHEREAS, the **ALS BARUGO II** an education institution that provides a practical option to the existing formal instruction, both the non- formal and informal sources of knowledge and skills. To foster strong partnership and shared responsibility with all stakeholders, there is a need to ensure its sustainability through partnership with the local government and the academe.\

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby and stipulate.

A. RESPONSIBILITIES OF EVSU

1. The **EVSU** shall provide experts and available skills and technical manpower and other resources to the **LGU BARUGO** and **ALS BARUGO II** whenever required by the latter's Alternative Learning program;
2. Inform **ALS BARUGO II** of any supplies or materials required by its personnel in the conduct of skills and technical assistance;
3. The **EVSU** shall implement Extension Plans, Programs and Projects but not limited to the implementation of **Empowering ALS Learners through E-BE-Cs Program** (Enhancing Basic Education through Community-based Learning and Skills Training);
4. The **EVSU** shall make the training designs for the implementation of the **Empowering ALS Learners through E-BECs Program** (Enhancing Basic Education through Community-based Learning and Skills Training);
 - a. Science and Mathematics and Problem Solving Skills
 - b. Digital Citizenship
 - c. Life and Career Skills
 - d. Financial Literacy
 - e. GAD Orientation
5. Coordinate with **ALS BARUGO II** in the implementation of any activities;
6. The **EVSU** shall provide training materials, venue and food during the conduct of the trainings;
7. The **EVSU** shall monitor and evaluate every activity conducted and provide reports that **ALS BARUGO II** would require.

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B. RESPONSIBILITIES OF ALS BARUGO II


1. Inform and coordinate with EVSU the conduct of operation improvement that will require their technical assistance;
2. Coordinate with EVSU the conduct of operation improvement, and Alternative learning programs that will require necessary technical assistance from ALS **BARUGO II**;
3. Provide modules and other instructional material to be used to create training design.
4. Organize and inform the learners of the schedule of classes/trainings.
5. Assist ALS learners with their transportation to the venue.


C. THE FOLLOWING POINTS OF UNDERSTANDING ARE INCLUDED:

1. The parties approved the implementation of the **Empowering ALS Learners through E-BECs Program**;
2. The parties shall help each other source out resources and/or materials for the program.


D. EFFECTIVELY


