This **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT** made and entered into at **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (EVSU)** Main Campus Tacloban City, Leyte, Philippines this May 20, 2021 by and between

The **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY** Main Campus Tacloban City, Leyte, Philippines represented by its President, **DR. DENNIS C. DE PAZ**, hereinafter referred to as **EVSU**

- and -

The **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TACLOBAN CITY DIVISION** Tacloban City, Leyte, Philippines represented by its OIC-Schools Division Superintendent, **DR. SHERLITA A. PALMA, CESO VI**, hereinafter referred to as **DepEd**.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (EVSU)**, is a higher learning institution mandated to develop the potentialities of Region VIII;

WHEREAS, the **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (EVSU)** in fulfillment to its mandate to help empower communities by providing the needed technological profound expertise of the university through the Extension Services Program, and its efforts to help contribute to the rehabilitation and rebuilding programs to its development partners and identified clients;

WHEREAS, the **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION** is enjoined to serve as a partner institution in the implementation of the **CARE (Create a Reading Environment) Program**;

WHEREAS, the **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION** formulates, implements, and coordinates policies, plans, programs and projects in the areas of formal and non-formal basic education. It supervises all elementary and secondary education institutions, including alternative learning systems, both public and private; and provides for the establishment and maintenance of a complete, adequate, and integrated system of basic education relevant to the goals of national development.

WHEREAS, the **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY**, in collaboration with the **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TACLOBAN CITY DIVISION**, will work together to implement the **CARE (Create a Reading Environment) Program**, an extension program of the Department of Languages and Literature College of Arts and Sciences that aims to train teachers and learners in the elementary and secondary level in order to improve learners' reading skills and teachers' reading teaching skills.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree and stipulate.

A. RESPONSIBILITIES OF EVSU

1. Identify the beneficiaries and clienteles of the CARE program;
2. Provide logistical support for the implementation of the project;
3. Provide training materials and other resources for the training programs;
4. Facilitate implementation of the program; and
5. Monitor program beneficiaries and strictly ensure regular attendance throughout the training course.
6. Conduct the closing program after one year of implementation of the CARE Program
7. Assess the program implementation from conceptualization to evaluation phases.

B. RESPONSIBILITIES OF DEPED TACLOBAN CITY DIVISION

1. Serve as a partner agency in the implementation of the CARE program.

C. THE FOLLOWING POINTS OF UNDERSTANDING ARE ALSO INCLUDED:

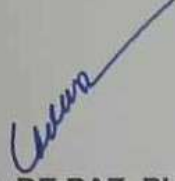
1. The parties approved of the implementation of the **CARE (Create a Reading Environment) Program**; and
2. The parties shall consult each other as regards to the total implementation of the program.

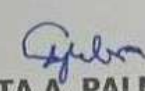
D. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE

The Agreement shall be effective, valid and binding for **one (1) year** from the date of signing by the contracting partners without prejudice to the revisions or modifications of any or some of the provisions which may hereinafter be agreed upon by the contracting parties that such revisions or modifications are consistent with the original intent and purpose of the agreement. Nothing may prevent any of the contracting parties from terminating this agreement for any unjustifiable reason upon fifteen (15) days of notice.

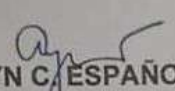
