KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** made and entered into at Barangay Local Government Unit of Barangay Bagacay East, La Paz, Leyte, on _____ by and between:

The **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (EVSU)** is a government agency duly created under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with an office address at Arch. Lino R. Gonzaga Avenue, Tacloban City, herein represented by its University President, **DR. DENNIS C. DE PAZ**, hereinafter referred to as EVSU;

and

BARANGAY BAGACAY EAST COUNCIL, a basic political unit and the primary planning and implementing unit of the government, with an office address at Barangay Hall, Barangay Bagacay East, La Paz, Leyte herein represented by its Barangay Chairperson, **HONORABLE SERGIO M. MALATE** and Sangguniang Kabataang Chairperson **HONORABLE JASTY JASON E. CAMASIN**, hereinafter referred to as **COMMUNITY PARTNER**.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the EVSU is a higher learning institution mandated to develop the potentialities of Region VIII.

WHEREAS, the EVSU is mandated with four major functions, instruction, research, production, and extension services;

WHEREAS, the EVSU implemented the **Empowering New Thoughts Revitalizing Entrepreneurial Potential (ENTREP)** Program in providing business education and support to the stakeholders and community partner of the Business Entrepreneurship and Management (BEM) Department an extension service of the **Bachelor of Science in Entrepreneurship, EVSU Tanauan Campus**.

WHEREAS, the **Bachelor of Science in Entrepreneurship** to implement the **Empowering New Thoughts Revitalizing Entrepreneurial Potential (ENTREP)** Program and the latter covers the conduct of Research Works/Activities, Project Training and Implementation and/or improvement of Extension Services delivery.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree and stipulate:

ARTICLE I POINTS OF AGREEMENT

1. The parties approved the implementation of the Extension Services Program/Projects of the **Bachelor of Science in Entrepreneurship** curricula program of EVSU-Tanauan Campus at **Barangay Bagacay East, La Paz, Leyte**.
2. The parties shall consult each other with regard to the total implementation of the **Empowering New Thoughts Revitalizing Entrepreneurial Potential (ENTREP) Program** and other related activities;
3. The parties approved the implementation of the **Empowering New Thoughts Revitalizing Entrepreneurial Potential (ENTREP) Program** of the EVSU-Tanauan Campus; and
4. The parties shall help each other source out resources and/or materials for programs and projects of the community partner.

ARTICLE II RESPONSIBILITIES OF EVSU

1. The EVSU shall inform its development partners of its intention to implement Research Development and Extension Services (RDE) of the **Empowering New Thoughts Revitalizing Entrepreneurial Potential (ENTREP) Program** in the area and shall closely coordinate with the latter of all arrangements to be made.
2. The EVSU shall implement the **Empowering New Thoughts Revitalizing Entrepreneurial Potential (ENTREP) Program** for technology transfer to Barangay Council and Sangguniang Kabataan Council of Barangay Bagacay East, La Paz, Leyte.



3. The EVSU shall provide the available skills and technical manpower resources that will be involved in its implementation of the **Empowering New Thoughts Revitalizing Entrepreneurial Potential (ENTREP) Program** for two (2) years period with the following activities:
 - a. Provide livelihood training, entrepreneurial skills development services and business/association registration.
 - b. Provide budgeting and financial literacy seminar to Barangay constituents.
 - c. Development, deployment, implementation, and transfer of the technology.
 - d. Provide training sessions and technical support to the end users of the project.
4. The shall further in writing the other party regarding the progress of the project.

ARTICLE III RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COMMUNITY PARTNER

1. The **COMMUNITY PARTNER** of Barangay Bagacay East, La Paz, Leyte shall assist/facilitate in the implementation/ monitoring of the program.
2. The **COMMUNITY PARTNER** shall assure the safety of EVSU-TC personnel and students in the locality;
1. The **COMMUNITY PARTNER** shall take charge of providing the needed supplies/materials if available for the RDE Workers and issue certification after completion of the program/project/activities.
3. The **COMMUNITY PARTNER** shall allow the use of necessary equipment available in its territory in connection with the implementation of territorial jurisdiction in connection with the implementation of the agreed program/project/activities.
4. The system maintenance responsibilities of the **COMMUNITY PARTNER** commence upon termination of the agreement.



ARTICLE IV
EFFECTIVITY

The agreement shall be effective, valid, and binding for two (2) years from the date of signing by the contracting partners without prejudice to the revision or modification of any or some of the provisions which may hereinafter be agreed upon by the contracting parties that such revision or modification is consistent with the original intent and purpose of this agreement. Nothing may prevent any of the contracting parties from terminating this Agreement for any justifiable reason upon fifteen (15) days of notice of intent.
