The **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (EVSU)** is a government agency duly created under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with an office address at Arch. Lino R. Gonzaga Avenue, Tacloban City, herein represented by its University President, **DR. DENNIS C. DE PAZ**, hereinafter referred to as EVSU;



and

The **MUNICIPAL ENGINEERING OFFICE**, primarily responsible in the administration and implementation of infrastructure development and public works project of the Local Government Unit, with the principal office at Dulag, Leyte, herein represented by its Municipal Engineer, **ENGR. CATHERINE B. CAPILI**, hereinafter referred to as **COMMUNITY PARTNER**.

WITNESSETH:

 WHEREAS, the EVSU is a higher learning institution mandated to develop the potentialities of Region VIII.

WHEREAS, the EVSU is mandated with four major functions, instruction, research, production, and extension services;

WHEREAS, the EVSU implemented the **Resilient Engineering Solutions for Utilization of Resources through Community Extension (RESOURCE) Program**, an extension service of the **Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering** of the Engineering Department, EVSU Tanauan Campus.  



WHEREAS, the **RESOURCE Program** includes Technology Transfer through the field of Civil Engineering, Strategies in Alleviating Community Problems, Advocacy on Safety and Health, Knowledge Creation and Innovation of Livelihood through Engineering Approach and the latter covers the conduct of Research Work/Activities for dissemination and or improvement of Extension Services delivery.

WHEREAS, the RESOURCE Program includes FEASIBILITY MAKING PROJECTS SUCH AS:

1. Construction of Wet Market: A Proposed Project in Kempis Street Brgy. Market Site Dulag, Leyte



NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree and stipulate:

ARTICLE I POINTS OF AGREEMENT

1. The parties approved the implementation of the Extension Services Project of the Engineering Department of EVSU-Tanauan Campus at Municipal Engineering Office, Dulag, Leyte;
2. The parties shall consult each other concerning the total implementation of any fieldwork activities;
3. The parties approved the implementation of RESOURCE Program with its project Feasibility Making Program of the EVSU-Tanauan Campus; and
4. The parties shall help each other source out resources and/or materials for the programs and projects of the community partner.

ARTICLE II RESPONSIBILITIES OF EVSU



1. The EVSU shall inform its development partners of its intention to implement Research and Development and Extension Services (RDE) projects in the area and shall closely coordinate with the latter of all arrangements to be made.
2. The EVSU shall provide the available technical manpower resources that will be involved in its fieldwork activities based on the needs of the community.



3. The EVSU shall implement Extension Plans, Programs, and Projects but not limited to the implementation of the RESOURCE Program of the Campus.
4. The EVSU shall provide the available skills and technical manpower resources that will be involved in its implementation of Feasibility Study on priority projects of the community.
5. The EVSU shall further in writing the other party regarding the progress of the project

ARTICLE III
RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COMMUNITY PARTNER

1. The **COMMUNITY PARTNER** of Municipal Engineering Office of Dulag, Leyte shall assist/ facilitate in the implementation/ monitoring of the program.
2. The **COMMUNITY PARTNER** shall assure the safety of EVSU-Tanauan Campus personnel and students in the locality;
3. The **COMMUNITY PARTNER** shall take charge of providing the needed supplies/ materials if available for the RDE Workers and issue certification after completion of the program/project/activities.
4. The **COMMUNITY PARTNER** shall allow the use of necessary equipment available in its territory in connection with the implementation of territorial jurisdiction in connection with the implementation of the agreed program/project/activities.
5. The system maintenance responsibilities of the **COMMUNITY PARTNER** commence upon termination of the agreement.





**ARTICLE IV
