This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** made and entered into at Local Government Unit of Tabontabon, Barangay 3 - Bonifacio, Tabontabon, Leyte on _____ by and between:

The **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY – TANAUAN CAMPUS, (EVSU-TC)** is a government agency duly created under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with an office address at Barangay San Miguel, Tanauan, Leyte, herein represented by its University President, **DR. DENNIS C. DE PAZ**, hereinafter referred to as **UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT**;

and

The **Local Government Unit (LGU) of Tabontabon** with the principal office at Tabontabon, Barangay 3 - Bonifacio, Tabontabon, Leyte, herein represented by its Municipal Mayor, **HONORABLE EFREN D. REDOÑA**, hereinafter referred to as **COMMUNITY PARTNER**.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the EVSU-Tanauan Campus is a higher learning institution mandated to develop the potentialities of Region VIII.

WHEREAS, the EVSU-Tanauan Campus is mandated with four major functions, instruction, research, production, and extension services;

WHEREAS, the EVSU-Tanauan Campus implemented the Strengthening Communities through Partnership, Advanced Research, Innovation, and Knowledge Transfer in Information

Technology (SPARK-IT) Program, an extension service of the Bachelor of Science in Information Technology (BSIT) of the Engineering Department.

WHEREAS, the Bachelor of Science in Information Technology to implement the FloodSense: Arduino-based Early Flood Monitoring System with SMS Alert (FloodSense) Project under the SPARK-IT program of the Bachelor of Science in Information Technology of EVSU-Tanauan Campus in which the former involves the implementation of the FloodSense Project and the latter covers the conduct of Research Works/Activities, Project Training and Implementation and/or improvement of Extension Services delivery.



NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree and stipulate:

ARTICLE I
POINTS OF AGREEMENT

1. The parties approved the implementation of the Extension Services Project of the Engineering Department of EVSU-Tanauan Campus at LGU Tabontabon, Barangay 3 - Bonifacio, Tabontabon, Leyte;
2. The parties shall consult each other with regard to the total implementation of the **Project FloodSense** and other related activities;
3. The parties approved the implementation of **FloodSense** Project of the **SPARK-IT Program** of the EVSU-Tanauan Campus; and
4. The parties shall help each other source out resources and/or materials for programs and projects of the community partner.

ARTICLE II
RESPONSIBILITIES OF EVSU-TC

1. The EVSU-Tanauan Campus shall inform its development partners of its intention to implement Research Development and Extension Services (RDE) and **Project FloodSense** in the area and shall closely coordinate with the latter of all arrangements to be made.
2. The EVSU-Tanauan Campus shall implement **Project FloodSense** for technology transfer to Local Government Unit of Tabontabon.
3. The EVSU-Tanauan Campus shall provide the available skills and technical manpower resources that will be involved in its implementation of **Project FloodSense** for one (1) year period with the following activities:
 - a. Development, deployment, implementation, and transfer of the technology.

- b. Provide training sessions and technical support to the end users of the project.
4. The EVSU-Tanauan Campus shall further in writing the other party regarding the progress of the project.

ARTICLE III

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TARGET COMMUNITY BENEFICIARY

1. The Stakeholders/ Beneficiaries/ End Users of LGU Tabontabon shall assist/ facilitate in the implementation/ monitoring of the RDE Services and **Project FloodSense**;
2. The Stakeholders/ Beneficiaries/ End Users of LGU Tabontabon, Barangay 3 - Bonifacio, Tabontabon, Leyte shall assure the safety of EVSU-Tanauan Campus personnel and students in the locality;
3. The Stakeholders/ Beneficiaries/ End Users of LGU Tabontabon, , Barangay 3 - Bonifacio, Tabontabon, Leyte shall take charge of providing the needed supplies/ materials if available for the RDE Workers and issue certification after completion of the program/project/activities.
4. The Stakeholders/ Beneficiaries/ End Users of LGU Tabontabon, , Barangay 3 - Bonifacio, Tabontabon, Leyte shall allow the use of necessary equipment available in its territory in connection with the implementation of territorial jurisdiction in connection with the implementation of the agreed program/project/activities.
5. The system maintenance responsibilities of the Stakeholders/ Beneficiaries/ End Users commence upon termination of the agreement.

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
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
**ARTICLE IV
