KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** made and entered into at Barangay Local Government Unit of Barangay Maribi, Tanauan, Leyte on _____ by and between:

The **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY – TANAUAN CAMPUS, (EVSU-TC)** is a government agency duly created under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with an office address at Barangay San Miguel, Tanauan, Leyte, herein represented by its University President, **DR. DENNIS C. DE PAZ**, hereinafter referred to as **UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT**;

and

The **Sangguniang Barangay of Maribi, Tanauan, Leyte** with the principal office at Barangay of Maribi, Tanauan, Leyte, herein represented by its Barangay Chairperson, **HONORABLE IRENE P. MACEDA**, hereinafter referred to as **COMMUNITY PARTNER**.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the EVSU-Tanauan Campus is a higher learning institution mandated to develop the potentialities of Region VIII.

WHEREAS, the EVSU-Tanauan Campus is mandated with four major functions, instruction, research, production, and extension services;

WHEREAS, the EVSU-Tanauan Campus implemented the **Marketing, Entrepreneurial, Financial and Operations Management (MEFO) Program** in Providing Business Education and Support to Micro and Small Business Owners of the Business Entrepreneurship and

Management (BEM) Department an Extension Service of the **Bachelor of Science in Business Administration** major in **Marketing Management Program**.

WHEREAS, the **Bachelor of Science in Business Administration** major in **Marketing Management Program** to implement the **Marketing, Entrepreneurial, Financial and Operations Management (MEFO) Program** and the latter covers the conduct of Research Works/Activities, Organizational Development, Social Preparation, Capability Enhancement, Promotion and Commercialization and/or improvement of Extension Services delivery.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree and stipulate:

**ARTICLE I
POINTS OF AGREEMENT**

1. The parties approved the implementation of the Extension Services Projects of the **Bachelor of Science in Business Administration** major in **Marketing Management Program** , BEM Department of EVSU-Tanauan Campus at Barangay Maribi, Tanauan, Leyte.
2. The parties shall consult each other with regard to the total implementation of the Four (4) Projects namely: **NEGOSYO-YAN-TE!**, **MONEY MASTERY**, **ORGA-NICE AND MARKET-MARKET** and other related activities;
3. The parties approved the implementation of Four (4) Projects namely: **NEGOSYO-YAN-TE!**, **MONEY MASTERY**, **ORGA-NICE AND MARKET-MARKET** of the **Marketing, Entrepreneurial, Financial and Operations Management (MEFO) Program** of the EVSU-Tanauan Campus; and
4. The parties shall help each other source out resources and/or materials for programs and projects of the community partner.

**ARTICLE II
RESPONSIBILITIES OF EVSU-TC**

1. The EVSU-Tanauan Campus shall inform its development partners of its intention to implement Research Development and Extension Services (RDE) and Four (4) Projects namely: **NEGOSYO-YAN-TE!**, **MONEY MASTERY**, **ORGA-NICE AND MARKET-MARKET** in the area and shall closely coordinate with the latter of all arrangements to be made.



The EVSU-Tanauan Campus shall implement Four (4) Projects namely: **NEGOSYO-YAN-TE!, MONEY MASTERY, ORGA-NICE AND MARKET-MARKET** for conduct of Research Works/Activities, Organizational Development, Social Preparation, Capability Enhancement, Promotion and Commercialization and/or improvement of Extension Services delivery form Micro and Small Business Owners of Barangay Maribi, Tanauan, Leyte.

2. The EVSU-Tanauan Campus shall provide the available skills and technical manpower resources that will be involved in its implementation of Four (4) Projects namely: **NEGOSYO-YAN-TE!, MONEY MASTERY, ORGA-NICE AND MARKET-MARKET** for one (1) year period with the following activities:
 - a. Development, deployment, implementation, and transfer of the technology.
 - b. Provide training sessions and technical support to the end users of the project.
3. The EVSU-Tanauan Campus shall further in writing the other party regarding the progress of the projects.

ARTICLE III

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TARGET COMMUNITY BENEFICIARY



1. The Stakeholders/ Beneficiaries/ End Users of Barangay Maribi, Tanauan, Leyte shall assist/ facilitate in the implementation/ monitoring of the RDE Services and Four (4) Projects namely: **NEGOSYO-YAN-TE!, MONEY MASTERY, ORGA-NICE AND MARKET-MARKET;**
2. The Stakeholders/ Beneficiaries/ End Users of Barangay Maribi, Tanauan, Leyte shall assure the safety of EVSU-Tanauan Campus personnel and students in the locality;
3. The Stakeholders/ Beneficiaries/ End Users of Barangay Maribi, Tanauan, Leyte shall take charge of providing the needed supplies/ materials if available for the RDE Workers and issue certification after completion of the program/project/activities.
4. The Stakeholders/ Beneficiaries/ End Users of Barangay Maribi, Tanauan, Leyte shall allow the use of necessary equipment available in its territory in connection with the implementation of territorial jurisdiction in connection with the implementation of the agreed program/project/activities.


**ARTICLE IV




