MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN THE

EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY AND BAYAN TELECOMMUNICATION, INC.

WHEREAS, on November 08 2013, super typhoon Yolanda struck Eastern Visayas. This resulted to 5,789 individuals dead, 26,123 injured and 983 missing; a total of 521,800 families (2,723,960 persons) were affected in 4,387 barangays, 7 cities in the 6 provinces of Region 8; a total of 420,197 houses were reported damaged;

WHEREAS, as an aftermath, many residents lost jobs and means of livelihood, while those who had stable jobs had to prioritize their budget for the rehabilitation of homes, purchase of basic personal and home items to replace those washed out or destroyed during the typhoon and for their daily subsistence;

WHEREAS, given this situation, agencies of government and the private sector were called to initiate collaborative programs aimed at contributing to the rehabilitation and rebuilding of lives, communities, infrastructure and the economy in the typhoon-affected areas;

WHEREAS, the EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (EVSU), in its effort to help contribute in the rehabilitation and rebuilding programs of government has to collaborate with various local government agencies and international non-government agencies / humanitarian organizations and the private sector;

WHEREAS, BAYAN TELECOMMUNICATIONS INC., a telecommunication company with a branch office in Tacloban City has a Livelihood Skills Development Program for its employees and their immediate families undertaken by its Human Resource and Organization Division Office;

WHEREFORE, in the spirit of unity and development and to expedite the rehabilitation and rebuilding process of Eastern Visayas, EVSU enters into this Memorandum of Agreement with the Bayan Telecommunications, Inc. in the implementation of a Technology and Livelihood Skills Transfer Program to their identified beneficiaries, all survivors of super typhoon "Yolanda";

The parties to this Memorandum of Agreement shall have the following responsibilities:

BAYAN TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.

- Identify the deserving clients / participants in the 1 day Culinary Course/Livelihood Skills Training in Baking on March 25, 2014
- Provide the logistical support relative to the conduct of said training i.e., ingredients, some utensils required by the Trainers, transportation for the participants

3. Provide a represe tive to oversee the preparation and acturanduct of the training

- Provide the Extension Service representative who will coordinate with the partner Company as regards, planning, conduct and evaluation of the training activity;
- Identify the Faculty members/Trainers to conduct the actual Baking Course for 1 day with follow up sessions if needed for consultation and advice;
- Through the Trainers, Conduct appropriate practical tests to gauge participant's comprehension and absorption of the lessons and issue their certificates of completion together with Bayan Telecommunications, Inc.;
- 4. Provide a suitable classroom/demonstration room/venue which will accommodate 40 participants and the appropriate utensils, pans, baking implements, etc.
