

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement is entered into by and between:

CENTER FOR COMMUNITY TRANSFORMATION INC., a duly organized and registered organization under the laws of the Philippines, with main office address at 5F, Joshua Center, 1428 Taft Avenue, Ermita, Manila, represented herein this act by its **President, Ms. Ruth S. Callanta** and hereafter referred to as "**CCT**",

and

The **MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF TANAUAN**, a local government unit duly created and existing by virtue of laws of the Republic of the Philippines with principal office address at the Municipal Hall of Tanauan, Leyte, represented herein by **Hon. Pelagio "Pel" R. Tecson, Jr.**, in his official capacity as *Municipal Mayor*, and hereinafter referred to as "**Municipal Government of Tanauan**".

and

The **TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY**, a national government agency created and existing under and by virtue of Republic Act No. 7796, with principal address at TESDA Complex, Brgy. Abucay, Tacloban City, Philippines, represented herein by its **Regional Director, Clea M. Omega**, and hereinafter referred to as the "**Second Party**".

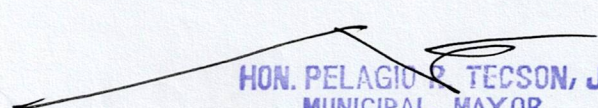

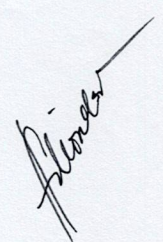
The **EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY**, the oldest higher education institution in Eastern Visayas that mandates provision of advanced education, higher technological, professional instruction and trainings, and progressive leadership, with principal office address at EVSU, Tacloban, Leyte, represented herein by its **President, Dominador O. Aguirre Jr. D.M.** and hereafter referred as "**EVSU**".

WITNESSETH,

WHEREAS, **Center for Community Transformation**, and hereafter called **CCT** for brevity, is a non-stock, non-profit organization registered primarily to serve the needs of Christian groups, communities and individuals working towards the effective transformation of the Philippine society, and is desirous of expanding its outreach to other community groups being assisted by the CCT Group of Ministries whose operations are governed by biblical principles and existing local laws.

WHEREAS, CCT is willing to work as the conduit of the Municipal Government of Tanauan, Leyte for their strategic rehabilitation response on Typhoon Haiyan,

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WHEREAS, the **Municipal Government of Tanauan, Leyte** is the local government unit that enacts and enforce local policies, and govern covered jurisdiction on the Rehabilitation phase of Typhoon Haiyan response.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Tanauan, has expressed interest to work with **CCT Inc.**, for the restoration of the holistic needs in the municipality in the aftermath of Typhoon Haiyan;

WHEREAS, the **Technical Education and Skills Development Authority**, and hereafter called **TESDA**,

NOW THEREFORE, all parties have entered into this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), subject to the terms and conditions herein below stated.

1. RESPONSIBILITIES OF CCT

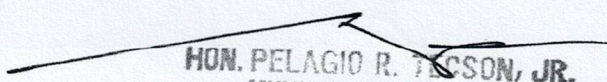
- a. Coordinate and collaborate with **Municipal Government of Tanauan** and **TESDA** in the conduct of activities for the immediate recovery of partner municipalities in Leyte;
- b. To provide the necessary manpower and technical expertise in implementing the housing assistance, livelihood development and community center setup aspects of the project, specifically
- Purchase of materials at the lowest possible cost
 - Submission of names and number of beneficiaries for the project
 - Submission of assessment and status reports every three months on the progress of the rebuilding efforts and the number of achieved targets complete with pictures; Timeframe to be agreed upon is within a 10 month period
 - Completion of the rehabilitation and rebuilding project within 6 to 10 months from the end of the fund raising period which is set at December 31, 2014
- c. Provide technical personnel to coordinate with the **Municipal Government of Tanauan** in the conduct of activities as set out.
- d. Manage and supervise the funds for the following activities:
- i. Enroll all identified 200 individuals into the Integrated Area Development Programs of CCT, Inc.;
 - ii. Upgrade or rebuild community centers that will orchestrate Integrated Area Development Program
 - iii. Provide Economic and Livelihood recovery assistance for the identified individuals / families / groups
 - iv. Assess and assist in the revival or creation of local industries.
 - v. Implement infrastructure-led area specific integrated development program that will assist in the reconstruction of housings, and repair of schools and training centers.

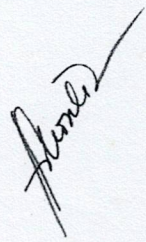

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- vi. Establishment of a restricted revolving fund to finance livelihood activities for the community members, and mothers and their families, to support recovery of incomes in Typhoon Haiyan-affected communities, based on CCT Inc.'s policies and guidelines;
 - e. Communicate and update local partners on any updates and issues that may arise from the conduct of the said activities;
 - f. Submit monthly and one (1) end of the project financial and technical reports to local partner on the liquidation and utilization of funds; and,
 - g. Perform other activities as may be deemed necessary.
 - h. To organize and schedule visits to the areas of operation every three months and to assist in coordinating logistical requirements at the field level (ie. ground transportation, accommodations etc)
2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF the MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF TANAUAN, LEYTE
- a. Participate actively and coordinate with local **partners and CCT Inc.** in the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of recovery activities;
 - b. Coordinate with the Eastern Visayas State University to provide venues for the implementation of the Integrated area development programme of CCT.
3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY
- a. Participate actively on the implementations of CCT through the provision of specific modules for the trainings.
 - b. Assess the competencies and provide the proper certifications for the trainees who finishes all the training courses.
 - c. Coordinate with CCT and the LGU of Tanauan in the implementation and monitoring of the skill training program.
4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY
- a. Provide avenue and support to CCT programmes and services
 - b. Provide necessary supplies for the rebuilding and repairs of EVSU rooms and structures as part of the skills training programmes of CCT.

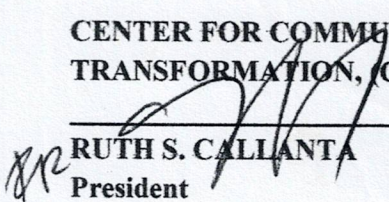
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5. EFFECTIVE DATE
