


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MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT



DENNIS C. DE PAZ**, hereinafter referred to as the "EVSU".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, NJVFI is dedicated to assisting deserving students from Leyte to cope with the requirements of achieving a college degree in pursuit of economic opportunities;

WHEREAS, NJVFI has established a Program to provide financial assistance to economically challenged graduating students who possess impressive academic credentials;

WHEREAS, EVSU is committed to providing accessible, high-quality education and fostering academic excellence, community engagement, and holistic student development with the aim of cultivating globally competitive, socially responsible individuals who value lifelong learning;

WHEREAS, EVSU collaborates with NJVFI in a Scholarship Program fostering future scientists, and skilled professionals, contributing to socio-economic development by providing employment pathways in relevant sectors;

WHEREAS, the EVSU expresses its willingness to partner with NJVFI in relation to the implementation of the Scholarship Program, has agreed to admit the NJVFI Scholars under the terms and conditions set forth herein and provide a list of qualified students already enrolled.


NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree to embark on the program under the following terms and conditions:


1.0 NJVFI shall:

- 1.1 Implement a scholarship program (the "Program") designed to offer financial assistance to five (5) economically challenged graduating students from Leyte enrolled at EVSU effective SY 2024-2025.
- 1.2 Of the five (5) beneficiaries:
 - o Each student shall receive a Meal Subsidy of ₱50 per day for twenty-two (22) days during their On-the-Job Training for the 2nd Semester of Academic Year 2024-2025.
- 1.3 The Foundation shall remit the equivalent amount for the referred subsidies to EVSU every 1st day of the month immediately preceding the referred month.
- 1.4 The Foundation is committed to this Program on a semester-to-semester basis.

2.0 EVSU shall:

- 2.1 Create scholarship committee to screen applicants.
- 2.2 Endorse qualified and deserving applicants to NJVFI.
- 2.3 Submit semestral reports indicating grantees' academic and extra-curricular performance.
- 2.4 Coordinate with the parents of the grantee, if necessary, any concerns affecting the grantees' academic performance.
- 2.5 Gather the following documents from the grantees to facilitate the disbursement of funds to the grantees through the payroll process:
 - 2.5.1 Original or Certified True Copy of Certificate of Registration for the 2nd Semester of Academic Year 2024-2025; and
 - 2.5.2 Photocopy of Validated School ID with three (3) signature specimen checked by the Scholarship Coordinators Office and verified by the Student Affairs and Services Office.


2.6 Submit liquidation reports for said fund to COA, and NJVFI if so required.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Both parties shall observe the following eligibility requirements:


- 3.1 The latest family income should not exceed Php 250,000.00 per annum
- 3.2 Applicant must not be a recipient of any other external scholarship/grants.
- 3.3 Applicant must pass the requirements of the school for the academic year he/she is applying.
- 3.4 Applicants must not be in any way related to any employee of the university.
- 3.5 Applicant must have at least a general average grade of 80%.

4.0 GRANTEES' OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 4.1 The grantee should carry an academic load of not less than 18 units during a given semester, or the equivalent of a full semester load as prescribed in the school curriculum;
- 4.2 The grantee should not be subject of any disciplinary action in or out of school;
- 4.3 The grantee should not take a leave of absence during the scholarship period without prior approval by the Foundation; and
- 4.4 The Grantee should follow the reimbursement process and comply with the requirements established by EVSU-BC



5.0 SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS

- 5.1 No party shall be considered liable, and no damage incurred in case this Agreement will be discontinued on account of force majeure, or due to a change in policy.
- 5.2 NJVFI reserves the right to terminate the grants anytime upon notification in advance for lack of funds and/or violation of any of the terms and conditions of this MOA.



6.2 EVSU shall ensure that the funds are properly allocated and disbursed to the qualified students in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

7.0 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

7.1 Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of all information related to the students and the details of the Program, except as required by law. and/or as requested by NJVFI for purposes of marketing and/or transparency to donor-benefactors. For this purpose, a written consent of the student-beneficiaries shall be obtained.

7.2 This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

7.3 Any amendments to this Agreement shall be made in writing and signed by both parties.
